



Arkansas State Trapshooting Federation Sponsorship Program

The ASTF is an Arkansas based, non-profit organization, whose purpose is to promote and encourage the sport of trapshooting, good fellowship, and sportsmanship.

The Arkansas State Trapshooting Federation holds their Annual Arkansas State Trapshooting Championship at the Remington Gun Club in Lonoke, Arkansas. Each year the State Shoot attracted around 300 shooters from twenty four states shooting at an estimated 160,000 targets over a five day period.

Each year prior to the Arkansas State Trapshooting Championship the Arkansas Youth Sports Shooting Program holds their State Tournament at the Remington Gun Club. The AYSSP is the nation's largest youth trap program. Shooting sports, like many outdoor activities, are great sources of fun and relaxation when practiced safely and responsibly. The Arkansas Youth Sports Shooting Program is focused on providing a fun, safe environment for participating in shooting sports and reconnecting kids with the joy of being outdoors. The AYSSP raises awareness of conversation-related sports, promotes safety, responsibility, and raises self-esteem. This year the AYSSP anticipates over 7,000 youth, 600 coaches and families from all over the state to take part in this program.

Last year several of the student athletes that have come through this program competed in the "Grand American" held at the World Sports Shooting Complex in Sparta, Illinois capturing numerous World Titles. This year five out of the ten young shooters who will be invited to try out for the Olympics will be from the state of Arkansas.

The day before the Arkansas State Trapshooting Championship is to begin the Amateur Trapshooting Association will hold its Academic Integrity and Marksmanship (AIM) Tournament. (AIM is the official Youth program of the Amateur Trapshooting Association). The purpose of AIM is to provide a safe and positive experience with firearms and registered trapshooting for youth, elementary school through college age. AIM encourages good sportsmanship and personal responsibility through competition while establishing the foundation to make trapshooting a lifelong avocation. Arkansas's AIM program is second to non.
