

ARKANSAS STATE AIM CHAMPIONSHIPS

White Flyer AIM Handicap & Doubles Championships Information

- Registration: The coach, shooter, or parent will need to classify, squad, and pay when Arkansas State ATA shoot registration tables open for the remaining events of the week (late afternoon Tuesday, June 18, or the morning of Wednesday, June 19). You will need your blue or orange ATA plastic card and your updated paper average card ready for the registration process (you may not have these if you are a new ATA/AIM member, just alert shoot personnel). You will register and squad for Event 3 & Event 4 of the Arkansas State Shoot. You do not have to shoot with your team members.
- If you ***did not*** note on the preregistration paperwork for Event 1 (AIM Singles) you are responsible for stopping by the AIM table between 9am-11am Wed (June 19) to let appropriate personnel know you are competing for AIM awards.
- ASTF and AIM events will be shot 'concurrently' with Event # 3 Lane A Warn Preliminary Handicap & Event #4 Steven R Powell Preliminary Doubles (immediately following Event 2 Tanner Cooper Preliminary Singles).
- Concurrent targets: Shooter shoots 1 set of 4 sub-events totaling 100 targets, and if you alerted the AIM management your scores are automatically entered in the two events. What you shoot in Event 3 and/or Event 4 will be the score used for the AIM Handicap & Doubles awards
- With the exception of AIM, a shooter may not win more than one trophy in the same event.
- NO ADDNL FEES for AIM Handicap & Doubles events; state shoot event charges only (\$34 per event and \$6 daily fee)
- Ties will be decided by reverse subevent for ATA awards and ties will divide Added Money
- Awards: please refer to the AR State Shoot program or the AIM program flyer
- Handicap – Shooters will be classified as detailed below and as published in the AR State Shoot program book. Less than 1,000 Handicap Targets shot in the current and previous 2 years will receive penalty yardage. Once Classified, the shooter remains at this yardage the duration of the entire state shoot unless Earned Yardage is awarded (will be displayed on Bulletin board). AIM awards will be awarded per Category, not by yardage.

HANDICAP CLASSIFICATION AND PENALTY YARDAGE

- Penalty yardage for Pre-Sub and Sub-Juniors is 20 yards
 - Penalty yardage for Sub-Juniors and Juniors is 21 yards
 - Penalty yardage for Junior-Gold is 23 yards

- Doubles – Less than 500 targets shot in the current and previous 2 years will receive penalty of Class B or higher. Once Classified, the shooter remains at this class the duration of the entire state shoot. AIM awards will be awarded per Category, not Class.
 - All 100 targets shot on the same field
 - For anyone new to the sport, please be aware that guns must be capable of shooting Doubles for Event 4; no stop & reload! 😊
 - Shooters competing in AIM Singles, AIM Handicap, and AIM Doubles will be eligible for AIM HOA award including a custom Tilden Trophies belt buckle and cash
 - Awards may be picked up 30 minutes after award list is posted on bulletin board. Any discrepancies must be brought to attention of shoot management immediately
